

Our athletes showcased their strength and determination at the Valour State Relay Championships, competing against the best in the state. All four teams secured top 10 finishes, with the Girls Open Race Walk Relay team earning a bronze medal. The Boys 13's Throws Relay team achieved 6th place, while both the Boys 14's and Boys 15's Throws Relay teams finished in 8th place. These results highlight the dedication and skill of our athletes, as well as the support from coaches and parents.

As we headed into the second half of the season, we had 197 athletes qualify for our annual centre championships. Throughout the day, an impressive 291 Personal Bests were recorded, showcasing the dedication and hard work of our athletes. We extend our heartfelt thanks to the athletes who participate week in and week out, and to the parents who volunteer their time to help their athletes qualify and compete in the event.

Like previous seasons, we had strong participation and performance across the Zone, Regional, and State Championships. A total of 171 athletes participated in the Zone Championships, 113 at the Regional Championships, and 25 competed across the two weekends of the State Championships. Across all three events, our athletes placed in the top 10 and set new personal bests. Reaching the pinnacle of competitions, five of our athletes competed at the National Championships in Perth, achieving remarkable results.
